



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Neuroscience Training Program Student Travel Awards, Society for Neuroscience Graduate Student Travel Awards, and Society for Neuroscience Postdoctoral Trainee Travel Award

Two student travel awards of \$500 each will be made by the Neuroscience Training Program in support of travel to a scientific meeting, conference or symposium between July 1, 2009 and June 15, 2010. Nominees must intend to present a poster or talk at the scientific meeting they will attend. In addition to the program's graduate student travel awards, the Society for Neuroscience Chapters Graduate Student and Postdoctoral Travel Awards will provide a stipend toward travel expenses plus meeting registration fees for the 2009 SfN meeting. The Madison, Wisconsin Chapter may submit two nominations for the Graduate Student award, and one for the Postdoctoral Trainee Award. All graduate student nominations will automatically be considered by the Program's Student Advisory Committee for both competitions. Post-docs are only eligible for the Society for Neuroscience award.

Nominations should be submitted by the major professor. The nomination packet should include 1 copy of each of the following items.

- Application form

- A one-page letter of support from major professor

- Personal statement from student explaining why attending the proposed conference or meeting is important

- A one-page C.V. from applicant

Travel expenses must conform with current state travel regulations. The award must be used towards travel expenses to the conference or meeting specified on the application form and the awardee must present a paper or talk. Awards must be used between July 1, 2009 and June 15, 2010. If a student wins both the Society for Neuroscience Award and the Neuroscience Training Program Award, the Neuroscience Training Program Award will be presented to the runner up.
